In continuing the tradition of service we are offering a scholarship in the amount of up to \$1,000.00. By offering this award we hope to encourage and reward academic achievement by providing financial assistance to students pursuing higher education.

Applicants must meet the following requirements:

Eligibility: An applicant must be attending an accredited four-year college or university in the fall of 2019; must have a minimum grade point average of 2.5.

Application: An applicant must submit a **typewritten** application accompanied by <u>an official transcript</u> <u>as well as an essay</u>. The essay (two to three, double spaced, <u>typewritten</u> pages) should state your educational goals, career aspirations, and any information expressing financial need. Briefly discuss the significance and impact of <u>one</u> of the following topics: Global Poverty, Social Justice and Human Rights, or Living a Healthy Lifestyle.

Deadline: Applicant must return all material no later than **June 24, 2019.** Applications postmarked after June 24, 2019 will not be considered.

Selection Procedure: The Education/Scholarship Committee will review each application and a winner will be notified by July 1, 2019.

Awards: Each recipient will be required to submit proof of full time enrollment for the fall of 2019 semester/quarter at a four year institution. Proof of enrollment qualifies as a letter or course print-out from the university's registrars office. Scholarship checks will not be issued until proof of enrollment is received.
